



The book of Galatians is one of the letters that Paul wrote to one of the early churches. This particular letter found Paul addressing some very Important life issues. He asks some pointed questions that help expose issues in the lives of the listeners.

In this series, we focus on three of those questions. Paul asks, "Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God?" This helps us focus on who our primary audience is. We must live for God's applause, not the applause of others.

The second question Paul asks is, "Have I now become your enemy by telling you the truth?" Paul reminds us that true friends are willing to tell each other the truth, no matter how difficult it may be."

Finally, Paul asks the Galatians, "Are you so foolish? After beginning with the Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort?" It is so easy to start to think that WE have the strength to accomplish this life on our own. We must remember that it is God's energy, not our own, that will see us through.

These 3 Questions are ones we should continually ask ourselves.
